- 18 Main Street** Cottage style garden with bridge over ornamental pond, raised vegetable beds, greenhouse and fruit trees.
- 30 Mansfield Lane** **NEW!** Enjoy "Tea in a Tent!"
- 8 Manor Road** An Eclectic Style Garden featuring a large pond with bridge and water fall/stream. Box edged paths, varied planting, ornaments and containers.
- 16 Lamp Wood Close** **NEW!** Mature tranquil garden, natural stream, with secluded seated areas - light a candle to a friend. Cream Teas
- 49 Georges Lane** Mature south facing garden sloping down to a babbling brook and a cosy nook.
- 212 Park Road East** Small garden with containers and densely planted herbaceous perennials.
